It is of greatest importance, for the safety of your child, that you wait in line and greet the member of staff at the door, with your child, so that we can all be sure that your child has gone into nursery.

Just a few reminders

Please can you name your child's clothing. Permanent markers are available in the nursery cloakroom. Your child will need a change of shoes, a pair of wellies and waterpooof trousers (to be left in nursery) and a coat suitable for the weather conditions as we go outside as much as possible. If shoes are wet please can they be put in the pastic bag inside your child's shoe bag. Your child has a named tray in the coakroom. Please check the tray when dropping your child at nursery for any information from us or for work your child wants to take home.

Snack fees are due. For returning children they are £15.60 New children £13.20 for 5 days and £10.80 for 4 days. **Please pay Mrs Green at office between 11.00am and 1.00pm before Friday 1st September.** We would really appreciate payment by cheque and if paying with cash the correct change would be helpful.

All About Me In order for us to find out more about your child, we have placed an 'All About Me' sheet into your child's tray for you to complete together and return to nursery, as soon as you can.

Staff training The nursery team have already had some training this term in Child Protection and are revising Infection Control. This will help to ensure that your child is kept safe and healthy.
