Reminders The children have thoroughly enjoyed having the opportunity to choose to be outside in the garden area during the nursery session and with the changeable weather we witnessed last week, we ask that you **ensure your child comes to nursery with a suitable jacket and shoes every day**, so they can enjoy this experience. Please also provide waterproof trousers and wellies if you have not already done so.



Drop off & Pick Up Please inform the member of staff at the door if your child is going to be collected by someone else. Children will only be released from the care of the Nursery to individuals named by the parent or person at drop off and recorded on the relevant entry record. If your child is to be collected on a regular basis by someone other than yourself, please let a member of staff know or contact the office so this will be recorded and means that you do not have to remember to inform us each time.

The children may tell you about Frog Points which they will receive as rewards for following the Golden Rules. Parking It is very important to remember to park in the designated school car park and not in the bus area or the drop off parking bays.

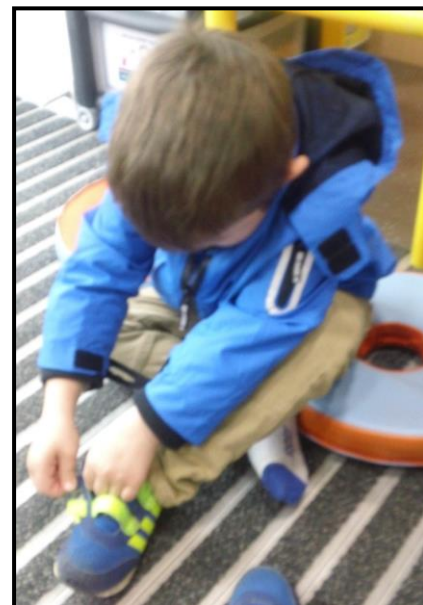
