Sports Day This is planned for tomorrow **Tuesday 21st May**, weather permitting from 9.30am-10.30am and **both afternoon and morning groups will come together for this.**

Morning Children - The nursery session this day will be as normal from 8.40-11.50am. Enter through the nursery entrance as normal.

Afternoon Children – The nursery session this day will be from 9.00a.m. to 12.00p.m. Please enter by the community entrance at 9am where Mrs Ewen will meet this class.

There will be no afternoon session.

Please ensure your child has suitable clothing and footwear. If it is a sunny day, can your child wear a sunhat and please apply sun cream to protect your child before they come to Nursery. Please also provide your child with a jacket as the weather can change very quickly.

The sports will be held in the MUGA to the rear of the school. Please enter through the MUGA on the pathway which runs from Drum Rd to KPS. 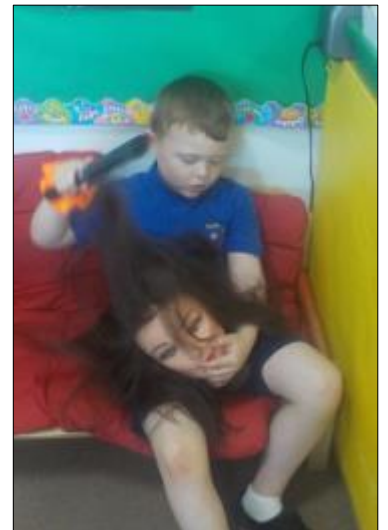
